Penguins are special birds. Though they have wings and feathers, they cannot fly. Penguins get around by sprinting on their large feet. These feet help make them good swimmers. Penguins also get around by sliding across snow and ice on their large tummies. Most penguins live in cold places. A thick layer of fat and their oily feathers help them stay warm. Not all penguins live in cold places, but some live on warm islands.

Penguins eat fish or shrimps. Most of them are black and white, but some types have other colours. They might have yellow or orange feathers on their heads and faces. Some have blue feathers. These fun birds come in all shapes and sizes. Some are short, less than 30 centimeters tall. Others can reach 122 centimeters tall. Smaller penguins can weigh one or two kilograms, while the large ones can weigh almost 45 kilograms.

Some penguins can live up to thirty years! Some live only five or six years. Like other birds, penguins lay eggs. The males keep the eggs warm until it is time for the eggs to hatch. Penguins travel in large groups called colonies. Inside the colony, the penguins live together as a family. This makes them very special birds.


